




touchdowns. The Cougars won the game 46-45, and it became known as the "Miracle Bowl."

In 1984, the Cougars went undefeated and won the national championship. They were led by quarterback Robbie Bosco, running back Vai Sikahema,


and wide receiver Glen Kozlowski. The Cougars beat the Michigan Wolverines in the Holiday Bowl, 24-17, to win the championship.

for 4,817 yards and 43 touchdowns that season. He led the Cougars to an 11-1 record and a victory in the Holiday Bowl.




The 1996 Rose Bowl
