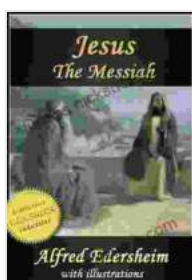

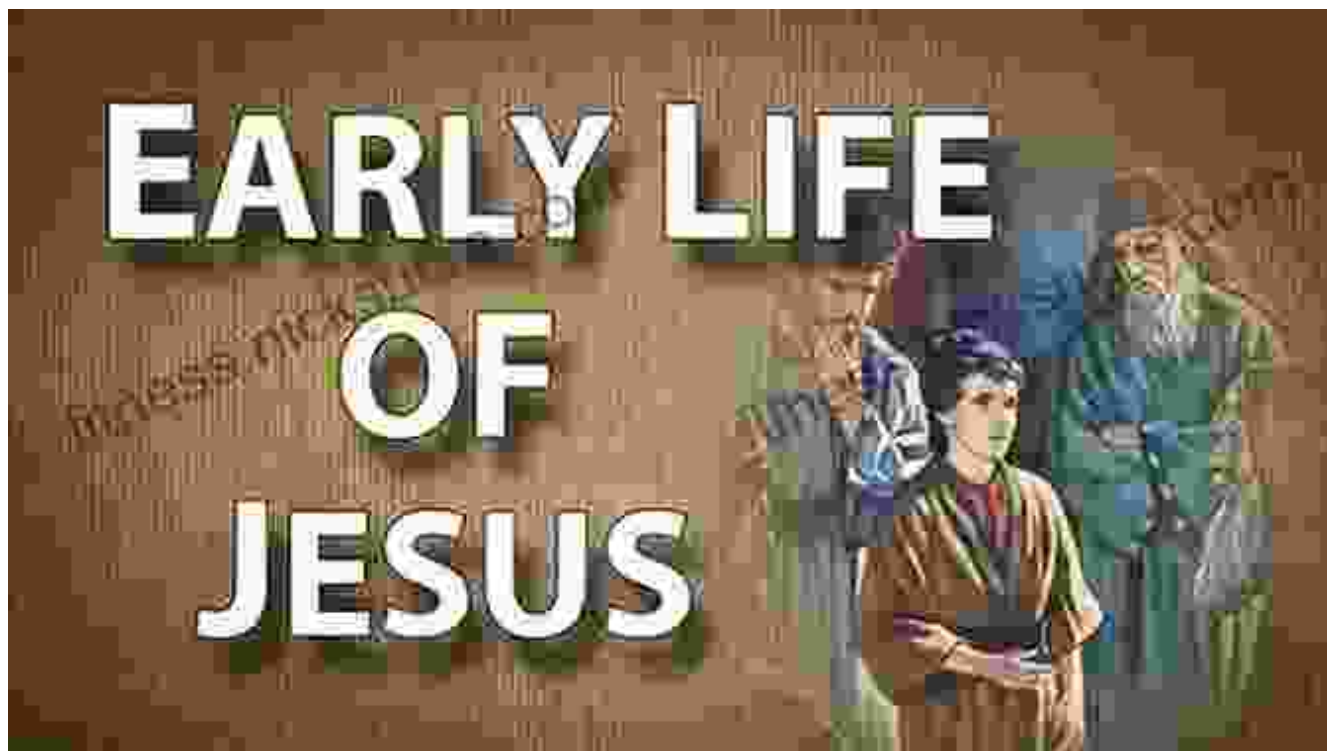

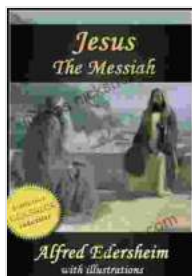
The Second Coming of Jesus
